On 9 May 2014, through your donations and support, we honored our Fallen by dedicating a Fallen Warrior Memorial statue of a Polynesian Warrior to the UH ROTC Program. This 12 foot, hand-carved, wooden masterpiece now sits in front of our UH Army ROTC HQs on lower campus and is a constant reminder of those who came before us and made the ultimate sacrifice in the service of our country.

Over the next couple of years, we will continue to raise money in order to construct an overhead cover for the Fallen Warrior Memorial to keep it out of the elements so future generations of Cadets and students can gain an appreciation for those Heroes who came before us. Along with the overhead cover for the memorial, there will also be a Scholarship Endowment fund granted to eligible individuals who wish to become part of UH Army ROTC and ultimately serve their Country as a commissioned officer.
