MEMORANDUM FOR Soldiers, Civilian, and Family Members Using the 298th
Regiment MFTU (RTI) Facilities

SUBJECT: Policy Letter #3, Speed Limit on Post

1. This memorandum establishes the speed limit for all roadways and parking lots within the confines of the 298th Regiment MFTU (RTI). This policy will apply to all members of the Armed Forces, civilian groups/individuals, government agencies, and family members of the aforementioned.
2. Speed is a factor in approximately 13,000 traffic related fatalities annually. Of those speed related fatalities, 86% of them occurred on non-Interstate roadways. With the types of battle focused training that is conducted at the 298th Regiment MFTU (RTI), Soldiers are freely maneuvering throughout the compound; this coupled with speeding is a recipe for an accident or worse, a fatality.
3. Therefore, as safety being the major factor, the 298th Regiment MFTU (RTI) has established there be a speed limit of not more than 10 miles per hour throughout the entire compound, to include roadways, driveways, parking lots, unimproved roads and traveling on terrain.
4. Violators of this policy will have their driving privileges suspended for a duration of time deemed appropriate by this command. Continued abuse of this policy may result in indefinite suspension of driving privileges. If you are a outside organization renting the facility, you may be removed from the compound without reimbursement or prorated refunds. Security Forces do patrol the area and will cite you for speeding.
